European Federation of Building Societies elects President

Brussels –Bernadett Tátrai was elected as the new President of the European Federation of Building Societies (EFBS). This makes her the first female President in the history of the EFBS.

Since January 2017, Ms. Tátrai has been Chairwoman of the Board and CEO of Fundamenta-Lakáskassza (Hungary). Previously, she worked as the Head of Retail for both Erste Bank and UniCredit Bank in Hungary. Tátrai succeeds Pavel Jiráček, a member of the Czech Modrá pyramida stavební spořitelna building society. Jiráček had held the office of EFBS President since March 2021.

The EFBS is a federation of credit institutions that promote and support the financing of home ownership. First Vice-President of the Federation is Sabine König, a member of Landesbausparkasse Hessen-Thüringen (Germany). She is supported by Second Vice-President Hans-Christian Vallant of Raiffeisen Bausparkasse (Austria). The operative business of the federation is managed by its Managing Director, Christian König (Germany). Mr. König is also the Managing Director of the Association of Private Bausparkassen in Germany.
