

Outgoing European Parliament (2019-2024)

- Heavy legislative agenda
 - Green Deal
 - Energy transition
 - Digital agenda
 - Covid
 - Financial markets
- 4 solid pro-European blocs (70% combined) in Parliament
- More second readings again
- Very active Parliament (see Covid, Big tech, Green dossiers)





Historical Developments

- Further decline of centre parties to be expected
- Continued growth of nationalist and eurosceptic parties

→ Composition of the European Parliament regarding share each political group, 1979 to 2019




The 2024 European Elections

- Big change expected with 2024 elections
- Greens could become 6th fraction



Projected seats by coalitions after the European Parliament elections in 2024




Note: Data elaborated in late March 2024, taking into account 720 seats



The 2024 European Elections

- Eurobarometer data shows that interest in elections is low (around 48%)
- **Chart below:** Stage of the co-decision procedure at which the Parliament and Council reached agreement on legislative texts
→ Trilogue procedure is becoming the standard



Next Commission 2024-2029

- Continuation of current themes
 - Geopolitical Commission, defense
 - Strategic autonomy
 - Net zero
 - Heavy implementation and enforcement agenda
 - China
- Regulatory pause?
 - Competitiveness, although member states do not agree on definition
 - Single market
 - Tighter application of state aid rules

Next Commission 2024-2029

- Enlargement
 - Ukraine and Moldova by 2030
 - Western Balkans from next year onwards?
- Institutional reform agenda
 - Treaty reform may be proposed

Next Commission 2024-2029

Finance Agenda



- Strengthen European banks and capital markets globally
 - Market cap of European exchanges halved, IPOs drop, little tech in Europe (only 5%)
 - Venture capital and private equity underdeveloped
→ only 7% of venture capital in AI start-ups, compare to 61% in US
- Exploit single market freedoms, integrate and consolidate
 - Industrial policy agenda for financial markets
 - Enforcement of rules, interoperability

Next Commission 2024-2029

Finance Agenda



- Regulatory pause
 - Single rule book is overflowing
 - From principles-based to rules-based model
 - Develop single ESG standard
- More EU-wide supervision, for infrastructures and data, for IPOs
- More differentiated supervision depending on functions and risk profile

Meeting with MEP Manfred Weber

- In November 2023
- Germany, EPP (CSU)
- **Overarching political situation**
 - Migration, Ukraine, Middle East
- European elections: **Demands by Bausparkassen**
- **Market-based mechanisms for climate protection:**
 - Extending EU Emissions Trading System (ETS) to more sectors, e.g. heating





Meeting with MEP Hildegard Bentele

- In January 2024
- Germany, EPP (CDU)
- Permanent ENVI and ITRE committee member
- **Financial education and literacy**
- Energy transition, stricter energy efficiency standards under the EPBD
- **Green Bausparkassen loans**



Meeting with MEP Christian Doleschal

- In April 2024
- Germany, EPP (CDU)
- Permanent ENVI and REGI committee member, IMCO substitute
- EU should make property acquisition more attractive
- Possibility: **Capping of property transfer tax** (Grunderwerbssteuer) in the member states
- More **incentives** for first-time buyers



Contact to other Organisations: Housing Europe

- Meeting in November 2023
 - Exchange of views and potential for future cooperation
 - Need for financial tools to **promote housing finance**
 - **Rising cost** of housing and construction
- Housing Europe event on housing cooperatives on 20 March 2024
 - Christian König gave institutional **perspectives from the financial sector**



ASMMA Meeting 2023 in Tokyo, Japan

- In December 2023
- For the Asian Secondary Mortgage Market Association (ASMMA)
- Christian König invited to **represent the EFBS and share a European perspective**
- Diverse set of global participants:
 - Indonesia, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, Uzbekistan, and more

 - In March 2024
 - **Covered Bonds & the European Green Bond Standard (EuGBS)**
- Joint meeting with DG JUST & DG FISMA
 - In April 2024
 - EBA Call for Advice on **green loans & mortgages**
 - **EFBS demand:** Commission should account for industry standards when designing a voluntary green loan label
